Below you will find all the information you need about participating as well as a form(s) that I need you to fill out and send back. Please print the waiver form and mail it back with your signature on it. The second form is your introduction page, you WILL NEED to fill this out and HAVE it with you or whoever is driving the float the day of the parade. These introduction pages are how your float/company will be introduced during the parade over the loudspeaker. Please be sure that this is legible, short & sweet and that you have it printed with you the day of the parade. These introductions will be picked up in the order you are lined up.

1. LINE UP: 10:30 AM starting at the Coloma hotel. Please line up end to end with the float in front of you, NO GAPS. If you are the first please come all the way up to the front. If you will have music I need to know so we can space you out using side streets.
2. PARADE STARTS AT 11am. The route will turn left on Front street and head to the park. You may go pasted the park and wait for the road to clear out to leave.

\*\*\*If you have a large entry that cannot make the turn from Main Street to Front PLEASE LET US KNOW, AND LINE UP down by the old Condon station. We will work you in accordingly.

3. There is no cost to participate, we only ask that you advertise on any social media your company has or website that you will be participating. We also ask that if you say you will be there you make your best effort to be present and on time.

The organization agrees to accept the following terms and conditions:

1. Maintain a minimum of 50" between units.
2. Units should maintain forward motion at all times.
3. Candy or other give-away items:
  - A. Must be thrown to curb or edge of road
  - B. Suggest individuals walking near curb distribute these items or edge of road rather than be thrown.
  - C. No alcoholic beverages to be consumed by parade participants during parade.
  - D. No person under the influence of drugs or alcohol will be allowed to participate in parade.
  - E. Reckless driving will not be allowed:
    - a. reckless driving needs to be defined as including but not limited to:
      - i. Stunt riding
      - ii Brake torquing
      - iii Wheelies
  - F. Speed limit – 15 mph
  - G. Vehicles that require a driver's license for operation must be driven by a licensed driver.
  - H. ATV or motorized toy must be driven by a driver that has passed necessary requirements for operation, including ATV safety course
  - I. No horse may be ridden or driven by anyone under the age of 12 without supervision of parent or other responsible adult.
  - J. Motorized vehicles may not perform routines.
  - K. Motorized vehicles should not operate more than 16' either side of the center line of the street.
  - L. No spraying of water on spectators or streets.
  - M. Animal units are responsible for clean up of feces.
  - N. Parade marshals are required – 1 per block of parade route.
  - O. The Village of Coloma reserves the right to cancel a parade if public safety warrants cancellation.
